Delve into the history of Italian golf and discover elegance and traditions.



GARDAGOLF COUNTRY CLUB



The Course

Experts consider the Gardagolf Country Club one of the best golf courses built over the past thirty years. Spread out over 110 hectares, the golf course was designed by British architects Cotton, Pennick, Steel & Partners. The Gardagolf Country Club offers 27 holes nestled between the Rocca di Manerba, Soiano Castle and the Valtenesi hills, offering an extraordinarily beautiful panorama. Cypresses, olive trees, centuries-old oaks, pines and holm oaks complete the setting.

The temptation to stop and admire the scenery can be overwhelming, but make sure you don't get too distracted, as the Gardagolf Country Club course is extremely challenging.

The Course had the honor to host the Kronenbourg International Open Sam Torrance in 1993, the Conte di Florence Italian Open Bernhard Langer in 1997, and the 60° Open d'Italia Telecom Mathias Groenberg in 2003.

The Gardagolf Country Club's philosophy is to offer its Members and Guests a highly maintained technical Open championship golf course, in a breathtaking setting, and a welcoming Club House offering services par excellence.

The Club House

The 27-holes Championship and the large driving range permit the Club to host various rounds of the most important national and international circuits, at the same time giving those who don't wish to play at a competitive level the opportunity to try their hand at a championship, yet fun course.

GOLF CLUB FRANCIACORTA



The Course

The 27-hole course Franciacorta Golf Club is situated in the heart of Franciacorta, in the province of Brescia, on morainic hills at approximately 185 metres above sea level, south of the Lake of Iseo and in the centre of a golf area of primary importance joining nine prestigious golf courses in a less than one hundred kilometres range.

The Franciacorta Golf Club, inaugurated in 1986 after having its golf course design rolled out by Pete Dye and Marco Croze, has over the following years developed into a beautiful and well-maintained golf course. Franciacorta Golf Club is characterized by smoothly winding golf holes through small forests, along the lake and with spectacular views over the valley and the surrounding vineyards of Franciacorta. The Franciacorta Golf Club is a place conceived for sporty and dynamic families: a wonderful oasis of green boasting an avifauna worthy of a reserve.

The technical characteristics of the Franciacorta Golf Club are, by accounts of all players whether professionals or amateurs frequenting it, of remarkable interest considering the "personality" of each single hole. A club intended, planned and constructed in order to become important and to enter fully between the most prestigious golf realities.

The tournaments organised by the Club in the course of each sport season are approximately 160. The annual average presence of players on the greens of the Club adds up to approximately 20.000.

The Club House

The Franciacorta Golf Club offers a spacious and well-equipped Club House with a bar, a restaurant, locker-rooms, a bridge room, and an outdoor-area with two swimming-pools and two tennis-courts. Here one can rely on efficient and cordial staff members, always at disposal to satisfy the needs and requests of both members and guests.

For players the club offers a driving range, a chipping green with a practice bunker, a putting green; moreover there's the possibility to rent a golf-cart and/or a trolley. The skillful golf instructors are always at disposal for improvements of the swing, and entering into the pro-shop one finds the latest brands of clothing and equipment for the game of golf.

GOLF CLUB VERONA



The Course

Spread out among vineyards which frame the Custoza hills in the west of Verona, and located in an immaculate, picturesque landscape, the Verona Golf Club offers an itinerary for the elite following the traditional golfing tourism of north Europe.

Set up in 1963, on the undertaking of a restricted group of friends, amongst others Alberto Farina, Everardo Macola, Harold Gent e Giacomo Galtarossa, with a 9-hole course which was skilfully mapped out by John Harris, it was doubled in the following decade as a result of the increased interest the initiative attracted.

In the last five years, and on occasion of the 40th anniversary of the foundation of the Club, the circle has undergone a complex and studied renovation process of its core areas – the reception buildings and the course, which were attentively and skilfully designed by Baldovino Dassù and Alvise Rossi Fioravanti.

At the first nine holes, which are enveloped in copious vegetation and made challenging by a green which is well supported by mounds and bunkers, there follows a conclusive sequence that is characterised by ample and undulating fairways which are nevertheless technically harmonious with the initial part of the course.

18 holes of challenging golf that gently follow the natural slopes of Garda hills among vineyards and old trees that offer breathtaking views.

The Club House

Awarded as one of the finest Italian Country Club house, it provides all those services and activities related to playing golf. Players and visitors are welcomed to this comfortable and elegant environment.

At the Golf Club Bergamo "L'Albenza", a wonderful course is waiting for you: 27 holes of high quality technical design, masterfully created by the renowned English architects Cotton & Sutton, subdivided into three courses (Blue, Yellow and Red).

It includes a driving range (with 25 shooting positions), a pitching area and two putting greens.

In 1996 our Club had the pleasure of hosting the "53" Italian Open, a competition of the European Tour.

The best Italian player, Mr. Costantino Rocca, began his career on this course, and he then became the champion known by everyone.

It is almost impossible not to be seduced by the silence, the colours and the priceless sights of nature when approaching each green: once you play at "L'Albenza" the place will remain with you forever, just like your special driver or loyal putter.
